Chardonnay

Chardonnay is the most popular of all white grape varieties, as the grape of white Burgundy it produces a variety of flavours and styles according to where it's grown and how it's made, from minerally, unoaked Chablis to the grand and complex, nutty dry whites of Meursault, Chassagne and Puligny Montrachet in the Côte de Beaune and while barrel-fermented Chardonnays tend to be the richest, most complex and long-lived dry whites.

Sauvignon Blanc

Another popular aromatic grape, its color is light to medium yellow with a tinge of green. Typically from light to medium body with different floral and tropical fruits aroma, it is a very popular wine in every occasion and ideal with fish, shellfish, chicken and pasta dishes. In the USA it is also known as "Fumé Blanc".

Chenin Blanc

The versatile Chenin Blanc's pretensions to classic grape status are mainly realised in the Loire Valley, France, where its floral aroma, apple and pear-like flavour and acidity contribute to long-lived dry styles and luscious sweet and, on occasions, full-flavoured sparkling wines, and goes well with chicken, seafood and fish.

Pinot Grigio

Synonym name of the Pinot Gris where grown in Italy. Planted extensively in Friuli-Venezia and Alto-Adige regions where it can produce crisp, dry wines with good acid "bite".

Semillon

Semillon is one of the only three approved white wine varieties in the Bordeaux region. The grape is also key to the production of sweet wines such as Sauternes. Semillon can produce dry wines to sweet wines, outside France, is also widespread in Australia, South and North America.

Cabernet Sauvignon

Best known as the "King of Red Wine" it has a deep red color, with richness and complexity of taste and flavor. Serves well with hearty foods.

Merlot

Often used as a blending grape with the Cabernet Sauvignon grape, it has developed into a delicious wine in its own right. Its color is medium to dark ruby, with a plummy fruit flavor and mellow tannins. It is a good match with beef, chicken and pasta dishes.

Pinot Noir

Pinot Noir is the classic grape of red burgundy. There's no other grape like Pinot Noir with its wonderfully heady perfumes, and thrillingly pure, sweet, red berry flavours of raspberry, loganberry, mulberry, cherry and strawberry. It takes well to French oak and, in bottle, develops truffley and gamey undertones. Dishes of pasta with red sauce, beef, duck and fowl would do well with this wine.

Syrah or Shiraz

Known either as Syrah or Shiraz, the grape creates a light, medium to heavy red color, with taste varying from peppery to black fruit flavours and spicy characteristics. Hearty foods such as beef as well as spicy Indian or Mexican foods serve well with this wine.

Tempranillo

Tempranillo is a variety of black grape widely grown to make full-bodied red wines in its native Spain. It is the main grape used in Rioja, and is often referred to as Spain's "noble grape". The wines are ruby red in colour, with aromas and flavors of berries, plum, tobacco, vanilla and strawberries.

Sangiovese

The grape popularly grown in Tuscany region of Italy. It was used in the production of various Chianti and Tuscany wines such as the famous Brunello di Montalcino. It is renowned for its medium-full-body structure and plum-like aroma and flavors.

Malbec

Malbec has its origins in the Bordeaux region of France. But nowadays it produces some of the top wines in the cooler regions of Argentina and Chile. It features such appreciative intensity and depth with raspberry and red cherry flavours.

Pinotage

Pinotage is a red wine grape that is South Africa's signature variety. It was discovered there in 1925 as a cross between Pinot noir and Cinsault. It typically produces deep red varietal wines with smoky, bramble and earthy flavors, sometimes with notes of bananas and tropical fruit.
