| | <i>A clear colour with a delightful foam. A lively, mineral nose with hints of brioche. Fresh on the palate, an elegant effervescence and harmonious lemon aromas.</i> | |

| | <i>Rich, fruity champagne with notes of vanilla and peaches. It has a good acidity, with green-apple flavors. Elegant and well-balanced.</i> | |

| | <i>The bubbles are fine, very open and expressive, delivers aromas of fruit and brioche. The Palate is lively, fresh and in total harmony with flavours of fresh fruit and honey.</i> | |

Beyond the richness there is a strong impression of consistency that prevails. The wine’s power is remarkably restrained.</i> | |

NV Krug Grande Cuvée \$950

Aromas of toasted bread, hazelnut, nougat, barley sugar and jellied fruits. On the palate it shows fresh green apples, almonds, marzipan, gingerbread, sweet spices and honey. Exceptional freshness with rich and tangy flavours of lemon and grapefruit enhanced by the subtlety of its fine and elegant bubbles.

2008 Louis Roederer Cristal Brut Millésime \$1500

The 2009 Cristal has an incredible richness as well as elegance. A blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from estate's vineyards, it has a toasty, yet pure bouquet of stone fruits, rising bread, white flowers, and toasted bread, as well as a terrific sense of chalky minerality.

ROSE NV Martel Cuvée Victoire Brut Rosé \$170

Light salmon pink in colour with aromas of red cherries, raspberries and dry-cured ham. On the palate it shows notes of licorice, crushed mulberries and a biscuity finish.

NV Taittinger Prestige Rosé \$220

Aromas of raspberries and cherries on the nose. A fine balance of a velvety texture and full-bodied taste. The flavours are reminiscent of fresh, crisp red fruits. Lively, fruity, fresh and elegant.

NV Fleury Rosé Brut Vintage \$270

Soft raspberry, strawberry flavours with sherbet notes that went on and on. Hint of brioche complexity.

NV Veuve Clicquot Rosé \$320

Copper-orange in colour. Expressive aromas of raspberry and very ripe wild strawberries. A full-bodied, structured, vinous palate which stays fresh. Length and character define this champagne.

NV Ruinart Rosé \$370

The colour is a delicate pomegranate pink with orange reflections. The nose is subtle and fresh, with guava, lychee, raspberries, cherries and wild strawberries followed by rose and pomegranate notes. The balance brings together a delightful freshness and voluptuous body, expressed by an elegant touch of mint and pink grapefruit.

ROSE NV Krug Rosé \$1800

Aromas of puff pastry and red-berry tart, which develop to honey and citrus fruits. Floral accents and notes of dried or stewed fruit, enhanced by the subtlety of its fine and elegant bubbles.

2006 Dom Pérignon Rosé \$2200

Its floral accents and notes of dried or stewed fruit will enthral your palate. Its extreme delicacy is enhanced by the subtlety of its fine and elegant bubbles.

2008 Louis Roederer Cristal Rosé \$3200

A light, bright pink with copper tints. The delicate effervescence develops into a persistent string of bubbles. Chalky with a bouquet of dark berries and fruits of the forest (blackberry, wild strawberries). The finish is velvety, silky and enchanting.

NV Geisweiler Blanc de Blancs Brut \$55

Burgundy, France
With a good aromatic intensity on the nose, it conserves its well-structured fruity notes with aromas of aging on lees. The palate is broad, lively with good acidity. The retronasal sensations are clean, fresh and persistent.

2018 La Montelliana Prosecco, DOC \$65

Treviso, Italy
Elegant and fresh on the palate. It shows exotic fruit characteristics, notably grapefruit and finishes with crisp acidity.

NV Crudo Prosecco, DOC \$65

Treviso, Italy
Dry, fresh and fruity, aromatic floral and citrus fresh fruit with a clean mineral aftertaste.

NV Jaume Serra Cava Brut Rose \$55

Penedes, Spain
With a good aromatic intensity on the nose, it conserves its well-structured fruity notes with aromas of aging on lees. The palate is broad, lively with good acidity. The retronasal sensations are clean, fresh and persistent.

2018 La Baume ‘Saint Paul’, \$65
Chardonnay
Pays d’Oc
 Dark gold straw color. Mild earthy aroma. Medium mouthfeel with loads of citrus and stone fruits. Lingering palate.

2017 Arthur Metz Vin d’Alsace “Sushi” \$65
Alsace
 This wine has a medium nose, shy aromas of citrus and green apples. Light on the palate with high acidity, green apples, citrus and soft, floral notes.

2018 La Chablisienne Petit ‘Pas Si Petit’ \$75
Chablis
 Floral and ripe fruit aromas on the nose with a lovely aromatic persistence. A well rounded palate, great texture, fresh and elegant, citrus fruit is prominent on the palate, with a fine chalky-mineral touch.

2017 Domaine Joseph Drouhin Laforet \$85
Burgundy
 A bouquet of citrus aromas, followed by honey and vanilla. Vibrant and fresh on the palate.

2016 Faiveley Bourgogne \$85
Burgundy
 Under the straw yellow colour, the medium and simple nose evokes floral and fruity notes. On the palate, it offers a broad mouthfeel that leads into a lengthy finish. Enjoy this dry, light and fruity white featuring refreshing acidity.

2016 Domaine Drouhin-Vaudon \$105
Chablis
 A dry and brisk wine, typical of Chablis. Brilliant yellow-green color. The aromas are reminiscent of lemon, citrus, asparagus. On the palate, the first sip offers is clear-cut and fresh impression, with a nice texture. Long on the aftertaste, with fruity as well as mineral flavors, becomes slightly honeyed when the wine is more evolved.

2018 Foucher-Lebrun Sancerre Blanc \$115
‘Les Monts Damnes’
Loire Valley
 Abundant notes of honeyed grapefruit, lemon rind, freshly cut grass and crushed chalk give the wine a distinctive minerality. Crisp, medium-bodied white.

2018 Serge Dageneau \$125
Pouilly Fume
 Exotic fruit, passion fruit, grapefruit, litchi, mango, citrus. Flint stone, mineral notes. White flowers, broom, boxwood, acacia, blackcurrant buds.

ITALY

2018 Le Due Torri, Pinot Grigio \$55
Friuli
 Exquisite dry white, fragrant on the nose bursting with citrus fruit aromas. It is fresh on the palate with an excellent balance of acidity and minerality.

2018 Tonno, Chardonnay Terre, IGT \$65
Sicily
 Aromas of apple, pear, honeydew melon and grapefruit. Medium-weight on the palate with a vibrant finish.

2018 Ricasoli Albia Bianco, IGT \$75
Toscana
 Pale yellow straw color. On the nose, aromas of elderflower, white peach and grapefruit. Fresh and sapid to taste, the good acidity of this wine provides pleasurable length and persistence.

GERMANY

2016 Klosterhof, Müller Thurgau \$65
Schwedhelm Trocken
Rheingau
 The Müller-Thurgau has a light, very fresh scent of tangerines and white flowers. Very lively in the mouth, racy and cheerful.

2018 Weinhaus Ress, Riesling Trocken \$65
Rheingau
 A crisp, light Riesling with a lot of character and great acidity. Medium-length honeyed tangerine and lemon, green apple skin and grassy earthiness.

SPAIN

2018 Franck Massard ‘Herbis’ \$65
Verdejo, DO
Ruedo
Herbis exhibits a floral perfume of acacia, roses mingling with exotic fruit notably litchi. Rather opulent this year with a touch of bitterness in the mid-palate.

2017 Viña Esmeralda, DO, \$65
Gewürztraminer
Catalonia
Pronounced aromas of rose, lychee and citrus. A wine that is delicate on the palate with subtle floral notes and a fine seam of acidity. Lengthy finish.

ARGENTINA

2018 Trivento Reserve, Chardonnay \$55
Mendoza
A brilliant gold tinged with green whose expressive mix of apple and banana aromas are touched off with pleasant vanilla notes from the 3 months aged in French oak. Silky yet fresh sensations make way for a delicate finish.

2018 Zuccardi Serie A, Torrontés \$65
Salta
This wine shows an intense yellow greenish color with a delicate and unique nose, full of white flowers, white peach, orange peel and oregano. The palate is well structured with a vibrant acidity and a good aromatic intensity, with a long and delicate finish.

2018 Casillero del Diablo, \$55
Sauvignon Blanc
Casablanca Valley
This characteristic is complemented by a mineral note for refreshing style with peach and redcurrant aromas. A lush and well-rounded wine with perfect balance and elegance.

2017 Caliterra Reserva, Chardonnay \$65
Casablanca Valley
A bright and lovely golden-yellow color with greenish rims, this wine displays elegance and freshness on the nose. Fruity aromas of mango and Williams pear are a nice counterpart to its citric and mineral notes. Well balanced with delicious acidity and good persistence on the palate.

2018 Santa Rita Reserva, \$65
Sauvignon Blanc
Casablanca Valley
Notes of fragrant citrus blossoms, pink grapefruit and ripe apricot are in balance with a delicate herbal undertone.

AUSTRALIA

2019 Stonefish, Chardonnay \$65
Margaret River
Displays a beautiful palate of citrus and peach with hints of spice with a soft, refreshing finish.

2018 Yalumba ‘Y Series’ \$75
Unwooded Chardonnay
Barossa Valley
This wine sees no oak whatsoever, the result is a fruit driven and delightful Chardonnay expressing aromas of tropical fruits, pineapple and melon with a touch of minerality. The palate is fresh with citrus fruit flavours and good length.

2018 Overstone, Sauvignon Blanc \$65
Marlborough
Ripe tropical and gooseberry fruit flavours with a zingy finish and impeccable balance.

2018 Babich, Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc \$75
Marlborough
Aromas of lemon blossom, lime and blackcurrant with a touch of guava. Textured and sweet fruited, current, gooseberry, apple and ripe citrus with juicy green notes and a gentle spice. Very long finish with lingering passionfruit.

SOUTH AFRICA

2018 La Vierge Original Sin, Sauvignon Blanc \$65
Walker Bay
Expresses the broad richness of the clay soils on the palate and aromatic tropical fruit and mineral character on the nose. Using a blend of yeasts and the intrigue achieved with the portion of Semillon, it shows concentrated tropical melon and pear drop, with a hint of lemon grass character and a full mineral follow through on the palate.

2019 Marras Piekenierskloof, Chenin Blanc \$65
Stellenbosch
This Chenin Blanc was partially natural fermented, combined with barrel and tank fermentation and matured on fine lees for 6 months. You can expect notes of stone fruit and pear skin flower on the nose and palate.

USA

2018 Bonterra Organic, Chardonnay \$75
Mendocino County
An initial impression of rich, buttery cream quickly turns to aromas of honey and lightly toasted almonds, followed by tropical aromas of pineapple, citrusy lemon and crème brulee. The wine is refreshing on the palate, with a minerality that is both bright and clean with a vibrant tartness and lemon zest.

2018 Les Soleillades \$65
Provence
A bright, light pink colour with wonderful perfume which comes through from the Cinsault. It tastes of crisp watermelon with a citrus twist over a delicious raspberry background. A fantastic food wine, as well as being an enjoyable drink on its own.

2018 Château Minuty ‘M de Minuty’ \$75
Provence
A magnificent wine of pleasure. The aromatic harmony of Grenache and Cinsault offers some notes of peach and candied orange. The mouth is fresh and round, filled with raspberries and juicy red berries.

ITALY

2018 Zaccagnini Cerasuolo d’Abruzzo, DOC \$65
Abruzzo
Typical pink colour of white vinification of red grapes, intense bouquet, fragrant, harmonious, very pleasant nose, on the palate, it is subtle and elegant, fresh and well-balanced.

2018 Mastroberardino ‘Lacrimarosa’ \$65
Campania
Delicate and fruity, with aromas of white peach, peony, strawberry, raspberry and plums. Balanced and soft, with notes of wild strawberry.

AUSTRALIA

2017 Jacob’s Creek, Shiraz Rosé \$55
Ocado
A dry Rosé that shows aromas of lifted strawberry and fresh raspberries. The sweet berry flavours are beautifully enhanced by subtle spice notes. The palate is luscious yet fresh, with a clean and crisp finish.

2018 Babich, Pinot Noir Rose \$65

Marlborough
Floral and fresh aromas of strawberry, melon and apple, and a touch of pink marshmallow. Creamy with notes of cranberry, nectarine and strawberry. Sweet fruits and spice linger through to the crisp finish.

2018 Fromm ‘La Strada’ \$75

Marlborough
An elegantly dry Ros  , delicately flavoured, good harmony of structure and elegance, fresh, bright and linear.

SOUTH AFRICA

2019 Mulderbosch, Cabernet \$65

Sauvignon Ros   Stellenbosch
Burst of ripe grapefruit aromas is followed by clean, mineral notes and hints of fresh strawberries. Freshness of texture, vibrancy and length. Purity of flavour.

2018 La Baume ‘Saint Paul’, \$55

Cabernet Sauvignon
Vin de Pays, IGP
This generous and vibrant Merlot shows upfront plum, red berry and cherry flavours. The palate is accessible with well integrated, a seamless and lingering finish.

2018 E. Guigal C  tes du Rh  ne Rouge \$75

Rh  ne Valley
Fresh fruits with red berries and spices. Full, round and racy with smooth tannins. A full-bodied, rich and intensely aromatic wine.

2018 Marc Br  dif Chinon \$85

Loire Valley
This bright ruby red wine has intense, refined and fruity aromas. There are nuances of cherry, strawberry and spicy notes. In the mouth, it has a subtle attack and a fruity, light structure. There is a fresh and aromatic finish.

2018 Michel Picard Bourgogne, \$85

Pinot Noir, Burgundy
Concentrated and fruity (raspberry, cherry, black currant). Well-balanced and fleshy nose, lovely structure for this regional appellation. Supple, elegant and round with some spicy notes.

2017 Faiveley Mercurey \$130

‘La Framboisi  re’ Rouge
Burgundy
Fruity powerful nose, which mixes greedy red and black fruit aromas and woody notes. On the palate it shows powerful and fleshy with flavours of raspberry and other very ripe red fruits. Its structure is powerful, with velvety tannins and a very long and fruity finish.

2016 Michel Picard Mercurey \$140

1 Cru ‘Clos Paradis’ Rouge
Burgundy
The nose has an abundance of sweet red berries, black cherry, licorice, black earth, forest floor, vanilla, leather and a chalky minerality. On the palate there are ripe strawberries and raspberries, cherry, plums, licorice, minerals, with tertiary notes of leather and wet leafs. This is a medium body Pinot Noir with a beautiful long finish.

2016 Le Due Torri, Merlot \$55
Friuli
A fruity bouquet with hints of raspberries meets a full, dry taste and clean, pleasant finish.

2018 Marchesi di Barolo Barbera d’Ásti, DOCG, Rure \$75
Piedmont
The nose is fresh and fruity, reminiscent of blackberry and red fruit jam, and it has spicy scents of vanilla and toasted hazelnut. Its taste is full-bodied and robust, with a slight touch of tartness. The woody characteristic is evident, however, it blends nicely with the other traits.

ITALY

2017 Ricasoli Brolio, Chianti Classico, DOCG \$95
Tuscany
Intense ruby red colour. Complex aromas of iris and violets, red fruit and balsamic scents. Soft, elegant and well-smoothed tannins in the mouth. A true expression of the territory with well-balanced acidity and mineral tannins, before finishing long.

2017 Masi Rosso del Veronese IGT ‘Campofiorin’ \$115
Veneto
Open, mature nose combining black fruits, stone fruits and oak undercurrents that are both toasted and chocolaty. Lovely fullness, fleshy fruit and freshness on the palate.

2016 La Spinetta Barbera d’Asti, DOCG ‘Ca di Pian’ \$135
Piedmont
Ruby red in color with purple reflections, this wine offers aromas of blueberry, wet earth and a hint of orange peel. On the palate, it is full-bodied with bright acidity and lots of intensity, but also balanced and silky.

2017 Pata Negra Roble Valdepenas, DO \$55
Castilla La Mancha
Intense red color, with purple tones. Black fruits and hints of vanilla. Well structured and balanced with a lingering finish.

2017 Brillo Del Dia, Tempranillo \$65
Vino de España
Dark ruby red with brick-colored reflections. Intense aroma of black cherry, pickled plums, sweet spices and a little bit of dark chocolate. Medium to full body with juicy acidity, soft tannins and long finish.

ARGENTINA

2018 Santa Julia, Cabernet Sauvignon \$55
Mendoza
Clear, medium purple colour, moderate aromas of blackberry, with herbal and spicy notes; extra dry and medium-bodied with flavours of juicy blackberry, spice and mocha; long finish with short term ageing potential.

2017 Catena ‘Zapata Catena’, Malbec \$75
Mendoza
Deep violet color. Aromas of ripe red and dark fruits, joined by delicate violet and lavender notes, with traces of vanilla and mocha. A rich, concentrated mouthfeel, highlighted by flavors of blueberries and blackberries with a touch of sweet spice, and leather. The wine finishes with bright acidity, well-integrated and silky tannins, and a flinty minerality that lingers on the palate.

CHILE

2018 Casillero del Diablo, Pinot Noir \$55
Casablanca
It is a delicate and bright ruby-red colored wine. Aromas of cherry and tomato. The wine is lean on the palate, with a fresh acidity. Tart, spicy plum and cherry flavors end on a crisp, finish.

2017 Novas Gran Reserva, Carmenere \$80
Colchagua Valley
This organic blend of Carmenere and Cabernet Sauvignon has a savoury and umami character. Notes of fragrant blackberry and blueberry are woven with grilled bell peppers, succulent spices, roasted herbs and capsicum. Incredible concentration and balance with a long and smooth finish.

RED WINE

2017 Planeta Rosso, DOC ‘La Segreta’ \$35
Sicily, Italy
An intensely vivid ruby colour. Aromas of redcurrant and mulberry and mint. On the palate the wine shows flavours of ripe wild fruits, balanced by a full and herbal taste. The tannins are soft and smooth.

2017 Casillero del Diablo, Cabernet Sauvignon \$30
Casablanca, Chile
Dark, ruby red in colour with aromas of cherries, black currant and dark plums. This Cabernet Sauvignon is very concentrated, rich in flavor, perfectly balanced, and boasts a satisfying and lingering finish.

DESSERT WINES

NV Catala Nova, Muscat \$55
Rivesaltes, France
The wine is intense and complex, with aromas of ripe apricot and peach, lychee, floral notes and citrus. On the palate, it is concentrated yet the acidity brings freshness and elegance, the finish is long with floral notes.

2018 Fontanafredda Moscato \$55
d’Asti, DOCG
Piedmont, Italy
This wine displays a straw-gold colour with fragrant aromas of jasmine, acacia, orange, sage and honey. On the palate the wine is distinctive, pleasantly sweet but balanced.

2018 Kracher Cuvee Beerenauslese \$105
Burgenland, Austria
Light straw yellow colour. On the nose the wine is sweet and seductive, with hints of honey, peach, exotic fruit and mineral nuances. The palate is juicy, sweet with citrus notes, balanced by a vibrant freshness.
