

Komani Lake- gem of Albanian Alps

With the view and climate of the Scandinavian fjords, Lake Koman is a haven that gives you interior peace. Located between the hills covered with greenery, it is positioned in the northern part of the country. Koman Lake is a reservoir on the Drin River that is powered by the Shala and Valbona rivers. It covers an area of 34 kilometers, from the village of Koman all the way to the village of Fierza. This lake is home to 13 different species of fish and amphibians. Koman Lake stands between the mountains of the Shkodra and Kukes region. It is incredible that such a beautiful place is the result of a reservoir built in 1978 near the village of Koman.
