

Mountain Jeep Safari

(Albanian Riviera - Pilur - Himara and Porto Palermo)

We head to the meeting point, where cars with drivers will be waiting. After a short instruction, we will begin our tour.

We will pass through several small villages with typical Mediterranean architecture. The first stop will be in the village of Borsh, where aromatic coffee awaits us in a pleasant restaurant, where a waterfall flows right through the building into the gardens. After leaving Borsh, we will pass through the village of Cheparo and head to a mountain village called Pilur. From Cheparo to Pilur, get ready for off-road conditions, where the entire road on this section will rush up the mountain.

In Pilur, there will be an opportunity to visit the church of St. Mary, walk around the village itself and chat with the locals.

After - a delicious lunch, where you can taste local dishes.

After lunch, we will go to the beach of Himara and stay here for about 2-3 hours. This beach is considered one of the best in Albania.

On the way back to Saranda, we will visit the castle of Porto Palermo. This castle was built in the 15th century (Venetian period) and was rebuilt by Ali Pasha in the 18th century (Ottoman period) as a summer residence for his wife. In the bay you can still see the old naval and submarine bases, which were very common during the communist era.
