White beaches with sand that seems talcum powder, crystalline sea and seabed with corals and colourful fishes, palm trees, lush forests and exotic animals, this is Zanzibar, one of the unspoiled paradises in the world.

Zanzibar archipelago is part of the United Republic of Tanzania and its main island is Unguja. The capital is Stone Town, recognized by UNESCO World Heritage Site, is a mixture of different ethnic groups and cultures where Swahili is dominant.



The climate is tropical monsoonal and has a high percentage of humidity. Normally the season of "Big Rains" begins in late March and lasts until the beginning of June. While the "Small Rains" is between November and December and can last until January. The dry season covers the months from December to February and from June to October.

## CLIMATE

You need a passport valid for at least six months from the date of departure and at least two free pages for the stamps. To enter the island, you must be in possession of an entry visa, obtainable at the Zanzibar airport at a cost of \$ 50.

## LANGUAGE

The local language is Kiswahili, but English is also widespread

## CURRENCY

The local currency is the Tanzanian Shilling (TZS), but Dollars (USD) printed after 2003 are also used.

The current is 230 V and 50 Hz. The sockets have three holes as in the UK and we recommend an adapter with flat slats, as the English type.
